Document: Please write your final project in the write-up. The write-up consists of the following:

1. Explain the topic and data set. Why is it interesting/important to analyze?
2. What kind of the data set?
3. Which method you have to use? What kind of a model are you using? Why are you using these methods and model?
4. If you are using software explain how it works.
5. What are the results? Conclusion.
6. Discussion: Pros and cons of methods you use. Is there any limitation? Any improvement you can do?
7. Cite all references.

There is no page limit.

Presentation: In the final exam, you are giving a 15-minutes presentation on your final project. You can make slides for the presentation or you can simply use the black/white boards to present.
